Course Aim

To instruct staff on correctly determining their responsibilities and duties when working On or Near the Line.

This course develops ability to correctly interpret Rule Book Track Safety Handbook and relevant instructions when required to go on or Near the Line. Delegates will also understand and be able to follow a Safe System of Work. A Network Rail course designed as an entry level competence. Any person joining the industry who will need to gain access to the track environment will need to attend.

Over two days candidates will be introduced the railway environment, potential hazards, walking and working on or near the line and emergency procedures.

- Walking or working
- Communication skills
- Emergency situations
- AC Electrification equipment
- DCCR Electrification equipment
- Track Visit

Objectives

At the end of this course learners will be able to:

PTS Initial AC & DCCR - Prerequisites

- Must be able to read and communicate effectively in English and have basic numeracy skills.
- Candidates must be 18 by the course start date.
- Form of Personal ID such as Driving Licence or Passport
- The primary sponsor must ensure that a Sentinel profile has been created on the Network Rail Sentinel website and their Medical and D&A information is valid, correct and uploaded to the Sentinel profile.
- Meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Competence Specific Fitness Medical Requirements.

Mandatory D&A Requirement:

- A negative NWR Drugs and Alcohol test must have been carried out no more than 3 months prior to attending a PTS initial training event and be uploaded to the sentinel profile.

PPE Equipment (required for practical element):

- Network Rail approved Steel Toecap and Midsole Lace up Safety boots.
- High Visibility (HV) orange upper body clothing to BS EN 471:2003 class 2 as a minimum (HV tabard) as per (GO/RT3279 & NR/L2/OHS/021) and Hard Hat.
- HV orange lower body clothing to BS EN 471:2003 class 1 as a minimum (HV trousers or HV over-trousers as per GO/RT3279 & NR/L2/OHS/021).
- Eye protection and general-purpose gloves that meet the EN388 cut 5 or new equivalent cut E standard on the Network Rail Infrastructure Projects worksite.

PTS Pre-Learning (e-learning):

- Must have successfully completed the PTS Pre-Learning training and assessment online via the Network Rail e-learning website prior to attendance.
- Must bring the Pre-Learning Completion Certificate on the day of training.
