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PTS Recert AC & DCCR - Prerequisites

- Must be able to read and communicate effectively in English and have basic numeracy skills.
- Candidates must be 18 by the course start date.
- Form of Personal ID such as Driving Licence or Passport
- The primary sponsor must ensure that a Sentinel profile has been created on the Network Rail Sentinel website and their Medical and D&A information is valid, correct and uploaded to the Sentinel profile.
- Meet the requirements of a Network Rail Standard Medical (NR/L2/OHS/00124) and Drugs & Alcohol Screening (NR/L1/OHS/051).
- The primary sponsor must ensure that the Medical and D&A information is valid, correct and uploaded to the Sentinel profile prior to the course being booked.

Logbook Requirements:

- Individuals must provide a PTS work experience logbook with a minimum of 4 completed and endorsed entries signed by the COSS or evidence of 4 PTS entries logged on the electronic logbook via Sentinel. If the 4 work experience logbook entries are not completed and endorsed correctly or available on Sentinel, the individual must attend initial training.

Please note that holders of a Sentinel card who are still in learning support (indicated by a green square on your Sentinel profile) will not be permitted to attend a PTS recertification course.
