### Course Aim

This is a Network Rail course designed to give learners the underpinning knowledge as part of their duties on Network Rail infrastructure. The aim is to provide learners with the skills and knowledge to carry out Site Warden duties in line with the associated capability of a Site Warden.

### Key topics

- Understanding of relevant standards and procedures of Site Warden duties.
- Know what Equipment is required for the role of Site Warden
- The role and responsibilities of a Site Warden
- Who is responsible for setting up, maintaining, and withdrawing a safe system of work.
- Be able to explain the risks associated with different safe systems (site warden) of work in relation to stationary or moving worksites.
- Fatigue management

### Objectives

At the end of this course learners will be able to:

- Carry out the duties of Site Warden to the standard of competence laid down in the written and practical assessments and in accordance with relevant Railway Group Standards.

### Site Warden Initial and Recert - Prerequisites

- Must be able to read and communicate effectively in English.
- Candidates must be 18 by the course start date.
- Form of personal ID such as Driving Licence or Passport
- Candidates must have a Sentinel card endorsed with a valid Personal Track Safety competency.
- A Valid PTS Medical and Drugs & Alcohol Screening must be uploaded to your Sentinel profile under correct sponsor.
- **Cannot attend if your medical states that you must be accompanied.**

This competence is valid for 2 years.

## Safety Training Centre Course Profile

### **Initial: PPE is required for the practical site visit.**

- Network Rail approved Steel Toecap and Midsole Lace up Safety boots.
- High Visibility (HV) orange upper body clothing to BS EN 471:2003 class 2 as a minimum (HV tabard) as per (GO/RT3279 & NR/L2/OHS/021) and Hard Hat
- HV orange lower body clothing to BS EN 471:2003 class 1 as a minimum (HV trousers or HV over-trousers as per GO/RT3279 & NR/L2/OHS/021)

### **Recert: No PPE is required.**

#### **Logbook Requirements:**

- Individuals must provide a Site Warden work experience logbook with a minimum of 4 completed and endorsed entries or evidence of 4 PTS entries logged on the electronic logbook via Sentinel. If the 4 work experience logbook entries are not completed and endorsed correctly or available on Sentinel, the individual must attend initial training.

**Please note that holders of a Sentinel card who are still in learning support (indicated by a green square on your Sentinel profile) will not be permitted to attend a Site Warden recertification course.**
